Japanese White Pine

### **Crnamental Characteristics**

Size: Tree > 30 feet

Height: 25' - 50' (equal spread)

Leaves: Evergreen

Shape: dense and pyramidal in youth; wide-spreading, artistic, horizontal layered habit in maturity.

Light: Full sun, Part shade

Hardy To Zone: 4a

Soil Ph: Can tolerate acid to neutral soil (pH 5.0 to 7.4)

Cultivar Name	Notes
Adcock's Dwarf	'Adcock's Dwarf' - slow growth; dwarf; dense; higher than wide; short leaves
Ara-kawa	'Ara-kawa' - rough bark; used for bonsai grafts
Bergmanii	'Bergmanii' - dwarf; rounded; wide-spreading; blue leaves
Compacta	'Compacta' - slow growth
Brevifolia	'Brevifolia' - narrow and ascending habit; few branches and twigs
Emperor	'Emperor' - emerald green foliage
Glauca	'Glauca' - common; slow, upright and narrow; blue, twisted needles
Glauca Compacta	'Glauca Compacta' - dwarf; narrow; blue, twisted needles
Glauca Nana	'Glauca Nana' - dwarf; narrow; blue, twisted needles
Blue Lou	'Blue Lou' - dwarf, dense broad-upright form; short needles are very gray-blue grows to 24" tall x 20" wide in 10 years
Aoi	'Aoi' - broad upright habit; needles are silvery blue on one side, green on the other
Blauer Engle	'Blauer Engle' - dwarf, broad upright form; has perhaps the most blue needles of any variety; dense foliage cluster fill in empty spaces and give the plant a fluffy look
Catherine Elizabeth	'Catherine Elizabeth' - dwarf, globe-shaped form; bluish needles; foliage clumps and mounds; grows wider than tall
Fukuzumi	'Fukuzumi' - broad upright habit; bluish green foliage; twisted needles; irregular, wide form, or it can be staked up for tree-like character
Glauca Brevifolia	'Glauca Brevifolia' - broad upright habit; blue-green needles in tight bundles, are shorter and have more of an upward curve to them
Goldilocks	'Goldilocks' - broad upright habit; silvery green/yellow foliage
Kinpo	'Kinpo' - dwarf, broad upright habit; bluish-green foliage; superior form and salt tolerance
Ogon janome	'Ogon janome' - broad upright form; yellow bands on the needles
Tanima no yuki	'Tanima no yuki' - dwarf, broad upright form; slow growing; creamy-white variegated needles

Cultivar Name	Notes
Blue Giant	'Blue Giant' - pyramidal form; slightly curved needles are silvery gray-blue; grows to 6' tall x 3' wide in 10 years
Cleary	'Cleary' - compact form; slow-growing; silver-blue foliage; grows to 6' tall x 3' wide in 10 years
Dr. Landis	'Dr. Landis' - slow-growing, irregular-shaped; needles are blue-green and tipped in cream-yellow; grows to 1.5' tall x 1' wide in 10 years
Eiko Nishiki	'Eiko Nishiki' - dwarf, compact form; short blue needles; grows to 3' tall x 2.5' wide in 10 years
