Ornamental Characteristics

Size: Tree > 30 feet, Tree < 30 feet

Height: 20' - 30' (spread 15' - 20')

Leaves: Evergreen

Shape: broad and pyramidal to spreading, loose, pendulous

Ornamental Other:

Environmental Characteristics

Light: Full sun, Part shade

Hardy To Zone: 5b

Soil Ph: Requires acid (pH 5.0 to 7.0)

Environmental Other: Siting is important - protect from winter wind and late afternoon sun. Snow loading will cause branch breakage.
