Cultivar Name	Notes
Aurea	'Aurea' - broad upright habit; needles emerge lemon-yellow, fade to yellow green; needle color complimented by purple cones
Blauer Eskimo	'Blauer Eskimo' - miniature; globe-shaped; unusual gray-green needles
Blauer Pfiff	'Blauer Pfiff' - spreading dwarf; blue-green foliage; reliably compact habit
Cis	'Cis' - globe-shaped dwarf; dark green needles lie flat on the stems
Fliegender Untertasse	'Fliegender Untertasse' - spreading dwarf
Golden Glow	'Golden Glow'- spreading; irregular; yellow needles, especially in winter
Green Carpet	'Green Carpet' - dense spreading dwarf
Kristall Kugel	'Kristall Kugel' - globe-shaped miniature rotating whorls of needles, recurved to expose silvery undersides
Oberon	'Oberon' - globe-shaped dwarf
Silberkugel	'Silberkugel' - globe-shaped miniature, tiny, dark green needles form a flattened, compact globe
Silberlocke	'Silberlocke' - broad upright habit; recurved needles displaying the silver- white undersides
Silberperle	'Silberperle' - globe-shaped miniature; pearl-like white buds in fall and winter
Starker	'Starker's Dwarf' - spreading dwarf; low, mounding; green needles
Tundra	'Tundra' - globe-shaped dwarf; dark green needles with bright white undersides
