(kam-uh-sip'ah-ris pie-sif'er-uh)

## Japanese or Sawara Falsecypress

#### **Cultivar Information**

Many cultivars, grouped into four categories: normal (like the species); Filifera (Threadleaf Falsecypress - stringy texture); Plumosa (Plume Falsecypress); Squarrosa (Moss Falsecypress - soft, wide-spreading foliage)

### **Crnamental Characteristics**

Size: Tree > 30 feet, Shrub 4 to 8 feet

Height: 50' - 70' (spread 10' - 20')

Leaves: Evergreen

Shape: pyramidal, loose, open; elegant, spreading branches; drooping branchlets

### **Environmental Characteristics**

Light: Full sun, Part shade

Hardy To Zone: 5a

Soil Ph: Can tolerate acid to neutral soil (pH 5.0 to 7.4)

Environmental Other: full sun to p/shade; prefers cooler climates

# Cultivars for Chamaecyparis pisifera

<b>Cultivar Name</b>	Notes
Boulevard	'Boulevard' - squarrosa group; dense pyramidal habit; soft, silvery blue-gray foliage; slow growing, typically reaching 5-6' tall in 10 years;mature size of 12-15' tall
Golden Mop	'Golden Mop' (a.k.a. 'Filifera Aurea Nana') - semi-dwarf, 4' high x 8' wide golden foliage; threadleaf foliage
Baby Blue Ice	'Baby Blue Ice' dwarf; dense, silvery-blue foliage; upright habit with age; 3' tall x $2.5$ ' wide in $10~{\rm years}$
Curly Tops	'Curly Tops' - globose semi-dwarf; grows very slowly, eventually reaching a mature height of approximately 4-5' tall; metallic blue foliage; twisted and curled branching
Cream Ball	'Cream Ball' - dwarf; grows very slowly (1-2" per year), mature height of approximately 2' tall by 2' wide; gray-green foliage with yellow-green to almost white tips
Ray of Light	Colorful foliage- white, gold, green
Soft Serve	Compact conical form, bright green foliage; 6-10' tall
Soft Serve Gold	Compact, conical form with golden fern-like foliage; 6-10' tall
Sungold	Dwarf, slow growing globe or broad pyramid. Golden thread-like foliage; 2.5-3' tall
