Crnamental Characteristics

Size: Shrub 4 to 8 feet

Height: 5' - 6' (equal or greater spread)

Leaves: Deciduous

Shape: round-mounded; erect stems

Ornamental Other: decidious shrub; beautiful flowers in May-June, ranging from white to bright yellow, orange and red; medium-fine texture. Green stems in winter provide seasonal interest. Need regular pruning.

Light: Full sun Hardy To Zone: 6b Soil Ph: Can tolerate acid to alkaline soil (pH 5.0 to 8.0) Salt Tolerance: Tolerates salt spray Environmental Other: Requires full sun and excellent drainage

Cultivar Name	Notes
Allgold	'Allgold' - dark yellow flowers
Burkwoodii	'Burkwoodii' - red flowers, bushy form
Hollandia	'Hollandia' - rose-pink flowers
Lena	'Lena' - a C. dallimorei hybrid; compact; dwarf; red and yellow flowers
Moonlight	'Moonlight' - pale-yellow to white flowers
Andreanus	'Andreanus' - upright form to 8' tall; bicolor flowers with red and yellow petals
Lilac Time	'Lilac Time' - a C. dallimorei hybrid; compact habit; reddish-pink and purple flowers
Minstead	'Minstead' - small white flowers flushed with lilac and purple; slender, arching habit
Nova Scotia	'Nova Scotia' - extra-hardy form with yellow flowers; hardy to zone 5
Pink Beauty	'Pink Beauty' - best pink-flowered selection
San Francisco	'San Francisco' - flowers are dark red
Stanford	'Stanford' - flowers are orange and red
Madame Butterfly	Masses of fragrant yellow flowers with red throats
'Sister' series	Sister Golden Hair- large, golden flowers and weeping habit; Sister Disco- red and yellow flowers; Sister Redhead- red flowers and upright habit; Sister Rosie- pink flowers with spot of yellow
