



## Species: *Betula alleghaniensis*

(bet'you-lah al-le-ghe'ni-en'sis)

### Yellow Birch

#### Ornamental Characteristics

Size: Tree > 30 feet

Height: 60' - 75' (100')

Leaves: Deciduous

Shape: pyramidal/dense to irregular/spreading at maturity

Ornamental Other:

#### Environmental Characteristics

Light: Full sun, Part shade

Hardy To Zone: 3b

Soil Ph: Requires acid (pH 5.0 to 7.0)

Environmental Other: Typically found in a forest, rarely in the nursery Does not perform well in hot, dry areas.

#### Insect Disease

susceptible to stem cankers, bronze birch borer, leaf miner

#### Bare Root Transplanting

Moderately difficult

#### Other

native to North America, Newfoundland to Tennessee
