Size: Shrub 4 to 8 feet

Height: up to 10'. Can be easily kept shorter by severe prunning in Spring.

Leaves: Deciduous

Shape: shrub

Ornamental Other: salmon pink new shoots age to white variegation and may be seen as a shrub or

grafted as tree form
