Ornamental Characteristics

Size: Shrub 4 to 8 feet

Height: 6'-8' typically

Leaves: Deciduous

Shape: upright shrub or small tree; becomes open with age

Ornamental Other: partial shade or sun

Environmental Characteristics

Light: Full sun, Part shade

Hardy To Zone: 5b

Soil Ph: Requires acid (pH 5.0 to 7.0)

Environmental Other: creamy yellow bell-shaped flowers with red veins; flowers in May-June; dark green foliage with red petioles; spectacular red fall color; useful as specimen or in border

Cultivar Name	Notes
Albiflorus	'Albiflorus' - pale almost white flowers
Red Bells	'Red Bells' - redder flowers
Red Velvet	'Red Velvet' - deep pink flowers
Rubrum	'Rubrum' - bright red fall foliage
Sikokianus	'Sikokianus' - darkest red flowers
Variegata	'Variegata' - variegated leaves
Weston Pink Strain	'Weston Pink Strain' - rose-pink flowers
Showy Lantern	'Showy Lantern' - deep pink flowers; dense branching; scarlet fall foliage; less hardy than species
Tokyo Masquerade	'Tokyo Masquerade' - variegated foliage; less hardy than species
