### Creeping Cotoneaster

#### Ornamental Characteristics

Size: Shrub < 4 feet, Groundcover

Height: 1 to 1 1/2 ' tall, with a spread of 4 to 6'

Leaves: Deciduous

Shape: Dwarf, low growing, compact and rigidly branched

#### Environmental Characteristics

Light: Full sun, Part shade

Hardy To Zone: 4b

Soil Ph: Can tolerate acid to alkaline soil (pH 5.0 to 8.0)

Cultivar Name	Notes
Little Gem	'Little Gem' (a.k.a. 'Tom Thumb') - 6" tall with a 12 - 15" spread
var. praecox	var. praecox - More vigorous, height of 3' and spread of 6'
Variegatus	'Variegatus' - white-edged foliage
Tom Thumb	Very low, cushion-forming plant. Dark green foliage and good fall color; 2-6 inches tall.
