Cultivar Name	Notes
Blue Star	'Blue Star'- dense habit, blue star-like leaves, 24" tall
Blue Carpet	'Blue Carpet' - ground-hugging form; silver-blue foliage; grows to 1' tall x 4' wide; a sport of 'Meyeri'
Meyeri	'Meyeri' - bushy, upright habit to 8' tall and narrower in width; bright blue foliage; plant may discolor in winter and it retains unsightly dead needles with age
Golden Flash	'Golden Flash' - 'Meyeri' sport with variegated patches
Gold Tip	'Gold Tip' - 'Meyeri' sport with yellow tipped foliage
Prostrata	'Prostrata' - slow-growing; ground-hugging habit; grows under 1' tall and mounds in the center; foliage is green with bluish bands on top
