Ornamental Characteristics

Size: Shrub 4 to 8 feet

Height: 6' - 8'

Leaves: Deciduous

Shape: very wide spreading and suckering

Ornamental Other: native to the southeastern US; adaptable to high pH; will tolerate moderate shade

Environmental Characteristics

Light: Full sun, Part shade

Hardy To Zone: 5a

Soil Ph: Can tolerate acid to alkaline soil (pH 5.0 to 8.0)

Environmental Other: striking coarse textured foliage; yellow fall color; midsummer showy white flowers

Cultivar Name	Notes
var. serotina Rogers	var. serotina 'Rogers' - blooms even later than straight var. serotina
var. serotina	var. serotina - differs from species by maturing to a larger size (eventually to 20' tall) producing larger inflorescences (to 30" long) and blooming about 3 weeks later in the year
