Golden Spring	'Golden Spring' (a.k.a. 'Aurea', 'Ogon') - new foliage emerges acid yellow with a tint of red and orange, maturing to a fresh canary yellow; foliage will hold its color in part shade; will fade to chartreuse in full sun
Variegata	'Variegata' - yellow variegated foliage
