Franklinia; Franklin Tree

Cultivar Information

Few cultivars for this species, all rare, none notably different from species.

Crnamental Characteristics

Size: Tree < 30 feet

Height: 10'-25' H, almost as wide

Leaves: Deciduous

Shape: rounded to conical dense crown, upright

Ornamental Other: originally native to Georgia. Now only found in cultivation

Environmental Characteristics

Light: Full sun, Part shade

Hardy To Zone: 6b

Soil Ph: Can tolerate acid to neutral soil (pH 5.0 to 7.4) Environmental Other: medium texture slow growth rate
