#### **Cultivar Information**

Few cultivars for this species, all rare, none notably different from species.

#### **C**rnamental Characteristics

Size: Tree < 30 feet</li>
Height: 10'-25' H, almost as wide
Leaves: Deciduous
Shape: rounded to conical dense crown, upright
Ornamental Other: originally native to Georgia. Now only found in cultivation

#### **Environmental Characteristics**

Light: Full sun, Part shade Hardy To Zone: 6b Soil Ph: Can tolerate acid to neutral soil (pH 5.0 to 7.4) Environmental Other: medium texture slow growth rate
