Size: Tree < 30 feet, Shrub > 8 feet

Height: 15'-20'

Leaves: Deciduous

Shape: upright oval outline in youth; more rounded and spreading with age

Cultivar Name	Notes
Arnold's Promise	'Arnold's Promise' - upright, vase-shaped cultivar; ascending branches; spreading habit; grows to 12-15' tall; sweetly fragrant flowers; later blooming than most of the other x intemedia cultivars; numerous bright yellow flowers from February to March; yellow-orange to yellow fall foliage color
Jelena	'Jelena' (a.k.a. 'Copper Beauty') - upright form; ascending branches; spreading habit; grows slowly to 8-12' tall; sweetly fragrant, copper flowers; bloom in February to March; orange-red fall color
Diane	'Diane' - superior red-flowering form, however blooms can be obscured as plant retains dead leaves
Primavera	'Primavera' - superior flower fragrance; abundant yellow blooms with a prominent reddish base; flowers early; features yellow fall color
Ruby Glow	'Ruby Glow' (a.k.a. 'Adonis' and 'Rubra Superba') - deep coppery-red to red-brown flowers that lack fragrance; vase-shaped habit; to 20' tall and wide; orange-red fall color
Sunburst	$\hbox{'Sunburst'-intensely colored, profuse yellow blooms; may retain some leaves that obscure the blooms}\\$
Westerstede	'Westerstede' - light yellow blooms with a light fragrance; flowers late (February to March); fall color is yellow; upright habit
