Crnamental Characteristics

Size: Groundcover Height: 1-1/2' (6' - 9' spread) Leaves: Evergreen Shape: low, spreading; dense, bushy Ornamental Other: evergreen ground

Ornamental Other: evergreen groundcover or shrub; blue-green needles may turn yellow in winter; often used as groundcover on sand dunes; medium texture; use as groundcover, specimen

Cultivar Name	Notes
Blue Pacific	'Blue Pacific' - low growth
Boulevard	'Boulevard' - horizontal main branches
Emerald Green	'Emerald Green' - low growth; soft foliage
Emerald Sea	'Emerald Sea' - low growth, mat-like, superior salt-tolerance
Silver Mist	'Silver Mist' - silvery, bi-color foliage
Iron Age	'Iron Age' (a.k.a. 'Irozam') - tolerant of harsh, dry conditions and salt exposure; slightly more upright habit, 12" tall x 6' wide
Sunsplash	'Sunsplash' (a.k.a. 'Variegata', 'Akebono') - bluish green foliage variegated with random sections of gold-yellow needles; variegation persists from year to year and remains fresh in all seasons
