Cultivar Name	Notes
Nana	'Nana' - dwarf form; grows to 1' x 1'
Lemon Fizz	'Lemon Fizz' (a.k.a. 'Lemon Twist') - lemony yellow gold foliage; grows to 18"
Pretty Carol	'Pretty Carol' - particularly vibrant yellow flowers; otherwise similar to species
Lemon Queen	'Lemon Queen' - white to extremely pale yellow flowers; denser than species
Small-Ness	'Small-Ness' - dwarf species; grows to 8" x 8"
Lambrook Silver	'Lambrook Silver' - more silvery foliage than the species
