### Ornamental Characteristics

Size: Shrub > 8 feet, Shrub 4 to 8 feet

Height: 5-12'

Leaves: Deciduous

Shape: rounded, upright

Ornamental Other: Dioecious flowers. White fruits are showy

### Environmental Characteristics

Light: Full sun

Hardy To Zone: 5b

Soil Ph: Can tolerate acid to alkaline soil (pH 5.0 to 8.0)

Salt Tolerance: Tolerates salt spray, Tolerates salty soil

Environmental Other: Tolerant of salt and extremely poor soils, showy white fruits, can be treated as an herbaceous perennial in cold climates
