

# Species: Crataegus punctata 'Ohio Pioneer'

### Ohio Pioneer Hawthorn

#### **Crnamental Characteristics**

Size: Tree < 30 feet Height: 20 - 30'

Leaves: Deciduous

Shape: horizontal branching, broad-rounded (almost flat-topped) crown

Ornamental Other: spineless form, white flowers mature to white dotted red fruits

#### **Environmental Characteristics**

Light: Full sun, Part shade

Hardy To Zone: 4a

Soil Ph: Can tolerate acid to alkaline soil (pH 5.0 to 8.0)

CU Structural Soil™: Yes

#### Insect Disease

Cedar hawthorn rust, fire blight, fungal leaf spots, powdery mildew, cankers and apple scab are occasional problems. Insect pests include borers, caterpillars, lacebugs, leafminers and scale.
