Crnamental Characteristics

Size: Tree < 30 feet, Shrub > 8 feet
Height: 15' - 20' (spread 15' - 25')
Leaves: Deciduous
Shape: broad spreading habit
Ornamental Other: full sun; tolerates air-borne pollutants.

Environmental Characteristics

Light: Full sun, Part shade

Hardy To Zone: 5a

Soil Ph: Requires acid (pH 5.0 to 7.0)

Salt Tolerance: Tolerates salty soil

Environmental Other: slightly fragrant white flower clusters in late spring; yellow fall color; shrub is late to leaf out

Cultivar Name	Notes
Emerald Knight	'Emerald Knight' - dark green glossy foliage; larger more profuse flowers; male selection; more vigorous and tree-like than species
Spring Fleecing	'Spring Fleecing' - fragrant white flowers, upright habit; dark green narrow leaves; male, so it blooms consistently and heavily every year
