Cultivar Information

Many cultivars, species, and varieties divided into groups with various color, bloom times, blooming on old or new wood; Florida Group (semi-double to double flowers); Jackman Group (flowers on new growth in July and August); and more

Crnamental Characteristics

Size: Vine Height: 5' - 18' Leaves: Deciduous Shape: twining vine Ornamental Other: \"warm top - cool bottom\" - roots prefer cool environment; avoid extremely wet conditions; some shade is preferred

Environmental Characteristics

Light: Full sun, Part shade Hardy To Zone: 4a Soil Ph: Can tolerate acid to neutral soil (pH 5.0 to 7.4) Environmental Other: bright green to blue-green foliage; beautiful violet-purple flowers 4

Insect Disease

leaf spot and stem rot can be serious; black blister beetle, clematis borer, mites, whiteflies, scales and root-knot nematodes
