Crnamental Characteristics

Size: Tree < 30 feet

Height: 15' - 20' (12' - 20' spread)

Leaves: Deciduous

Shape: round; low-branching

Light: Full sun

Hardy To Zone: 5a

Soil Ph: Can tolerate acid to alkaline soil (pH 5.0 to 8.0)

Environmental Other: stiff zig-zag branches have thorns; lustrous dark green leaves; May flowers are

white and abundant; small red fruit not as showy as C. crus-galli

Cultivar Name	Notes
Paul's Scarlet	'Paul's Scarlet' (a.k.a. 'Paulii') - double, rose red flowers; susceptible to blight
var. aurea	var. aurea - bright yellow fruit
Crimson Cloud	'Crimson Cloud' - red flowers with a white center; shiny red fruit; more resistant to leaf blight than 'Paul's Scarlet'
Snowbird	'Snowbird' (C. x mordenensis) - hybrid with C. succulenta; flowers are white and double; poor fruit set; hardier than 'Toba'; can be suceptible to severe leaf spot defoliation
Toba	'Toba' (C. x mordenensis) - hybrid with C. succulenta; features double white blooms that age to pink and red fruit; potentially resistant to leaf spot
