Ornamental Characteristics

Size: Shrub < 4 feet

Height: 3' - 4' (equal spread)

Leaves: Deciduous

Shape: dense, compact, rounded

Ornamental Other: Pink buds open to pink/white flowers with sweet fragrance; blue-green leaves persist to December. Slow growing

Environmental Characteristics

Light: Full sun, Part shade

Hardy To Zone: 4b

Soil Ph: Can tolerate acid to alkaline soil (pH 5.0 to 8.0)

Environmental Other: Sun or shade; provide adequate organic matter and cool root zone. .

susceptible to virus

cross between *D. cneorum* x *D. caucasica*; do not move once planted; difficult to transplant except as small container grown plant; fruits and foliage are extremely poisonous. Holds leaves late into Fall.
