Cultivar Name	Notes
Nikko	'Nikko' (a.k.a. var. nakaiana) - dense, low mounding form; 2' tall, twice as wide; blooms abundantly; good red fall color
Aurea	'Aurea' - yellow variegated leaves
Variegata	'Variegata' - broadly-margined white variegation on leaves
Chardonnay Pearls	'Chardonnay Pearls' (a.k.a. 'Duncan') - chartreuse foliage; heavy blooming
Rosea	'Rosea' - flowers, rosy-grey on the outside and soft carmine within; otherwise similar to species
Creme Fraiche	'Nikko' with variegated foliage
Yuki Cherry Blossom	'Nikko' type with pink flowers
Yuki Snowflake	'Nikko' type with extra heavy blooming, white flowers
