| Cultivar Name      | Notes  |
|--------------------|--|
| Lynwood Gold       | 'Lynwood Gold' (a.k.a. 'Lynwood')- very heavy bloomer; bright yellow flower<br>that open very wide and are well distributed along the branch; upright habit;<br>purple-tinged fall color |
| Spectabile         | 'Spectabile' - bigger flowers, more floriferous  |
| New Hampshire Gold | 'New Hampshire Gold' - better flower bud hardiness   |
| Northern Sun       | 'Northern Sun' - better flower bud hardiness   |
| Gold Tide          | 'Gold Tide' (a.k.a. 'Courtasol') - low growing to 3'; dense, profuse flowering;<br>an excellent spreading ground cover   |
| Evergold           | 'Evergold' (a.k.a. 'Gold Leaf', 'Goldleaf') - maintain bright yellow leaf color all<br>season long   |
| Fiesta             | 'Fiesta' - variegated foliage, green with a deep yellow center   |
| Karl Sax           | 'Karl Sax' - deep yellow flowers borne horizontally; dense and bushy habit;<br>superior bud hardiness  |
| Spring Glory       | 'Spring Glory' - a better choice for warmer zones (USDA zones 7-8); grows to 10' tall; abundant blooms are deep yellow   |
